Active Participation of Students

Students are invited to actively participate in the school by:

- 1. preparing an *oral presentation on a research topic* (20 min. plus discussion, to be given during the afternoon sessions scheduled on Mon 5/9, Tue 6/9 and Thu 8/9)
- 2. submitting an extended abstract of the oral presentation (2 A4 pages formatted following the "Student Abstract Template" provided at the school page at www.setnanometro.eu/events)
- 3. submitting one additional page containing a *summary of the overall PhD/postdoc research project* (250 word max.) and a *graphical abstract* (12x16 cm max.) prepared using the provided "*Summary and GA Template*" (same link as above)

The students are kindly requested to submit the material as word files named "Surname_abstract.docx" and "Surname_summaryGA.docx" and to mail them as attached to the address setnamo.school@unito.it (with the indication "Surname: abstract and GA" in the object field). Please notice that GA and figures (if present) should be optimized for the final publication in black and white.

The <u>new</u> deadline for the summary and GA submission is **10 August 2016**.

The abstracts, the summaries and the GAs will be collected in a book indexed through an ISBN code and distributed to all participants during the school.

Three <u>best oral presentations</u> and one <u>most appealing GA</u> will be chosen following a procedure illustrated during the school and awarded with (small) prizes.

All the registered students will receive a certificate of participation with the indication of the accredited ECTS (on request: please ask your institution for details about the number).
